

Water Resources Development Act Projects

Congressman Heath Shuler submitted the following projects on December 3, 2009 to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure for potential inclusion in the next Water Resources Development Act (WRDA):

- 1. Smoky Mountain Host of North Carolina, \$350,000**
Multi-purpose river restoration initiative to provide environmental and recreation enhancements. Funds to be used for environmental studies, planning.
- 2. City of Asheville, \$2,126,250**
Dam rehabilitation, preserving and enhancing flood control features, removing fill from the floodplain, providing stream restoration.
- 3. Clay County, \$1,000,000**
Increase the permitted capacity of the existing wastewater treatment plant by constructing a 0.170 MGD expansion.
