### **Rep. Shuler to Announce Introduction of Bipartisan SAVE Act Tomorrow** *SAVE Act will Secure America's Borders, Provide Employers with Tools to Verify Work Eligibility*

**Washington, D.C.** – Representative Heath Shuler will hold a news conference tomorrow, November 6<sup>th</sup>, to announce the introduction of the Secure America through Verification and Enforcement, SAVE Act.

The SAVE Act is a commonsense three-point plan to reduce illegal immigration. First, it calls for the hiring of 8,000 new Border Patrol Agents to secure America's borders. Second, provides employers with a tool to verify the work eligibility of their employees by expanding the E-Verify program to all businesses. Third, improves the enforcement of current federal laws through better coordination between federal, state, and local law enforcement.

The SAVE Act already enjoys broad bipartisan support with over 75 original cosponsors.
